# **Gutters & Skylight Cleaning**

Please be advised that your gutters and porch roof tops have recently been cleared of debris. However, due to the heavy moss on most roofs we have had to postpone the cleaning of the skylight windows until the weather improves, as the wet and slippery moss presents a health and safety concern for contractors.

Due to the recent extremely wet weather many of you may be concerned with the damp patches on the front of your houses. We can assure you that this isn't linked to full gutters, but is instead an indication that the 'drip felt' has been trimmed too short along your roof line so that rain water drips down the front wall rather than into the gutter. A roofer can replace this fairly simply, and you should expect to pay in the region of £300 to have this done.
